- Theatre performances (Greensboro Arts Alliance, Library Mystery Dinner Fundraiser)
- Support groups for people with disabilities
- Pleasants Fund Grants for local, community-based non-profits
- Outreach including local food shelf and emergency relief programs
- Sales for overseas and local artisans
- Free-trade coffee and chocolate for purchase
- Meeting space (Town Meetings, Historical Society, Greensboro Association, Caspian Area Business Collaborative, Caspian Arts, Library)
